

Honors Program Internship – Wyoming State Science Fair

The University of Wyoming Honors College is offering a part-time internship for a honors student in November through March 2021-2022 (excluding official UW holidays). This internship will provide candidates opportunities to assist with the Wyoming State Science Fair, a STEM research competition for middle and high school students.

Responsibilities:

- Aid in making logistical arrangements for ~300+ students and associated parents/teachers to attend the Wyoming State Science Fair and to publicize the program.
- Coordinating volunteer help (~50 people) just prior to and during the Wyoming State Science Fair event.
- Help develop science fair curriculum to mentor middle school & high school student science research and/or mentoring student researchers as needed.
- Help manage online registration and online judging processes from the Wyoming State Science Fair website.
- Commit to 133 hours of work with the Wyoming State Science Fair. Heaviest workload will be from Late January through Early March.

Ideal candidates will have:

- A science, engineering or math background and an interest in STEM research.
- STEM research experience (prior or concurrent) is preferred.
- Excellent organizational and interpersonal skills.
- Computer skills (Adobe Applications, Website Development, and Microsoft Office Applications).

Description of award:

- A stipend of \$2000 for the internship duration at a rate of \$15/hr.
