FIRST AID

IF ON SKIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Take off contaminated clothing.Rinse skin immediately with water for 15 to 20 minutes.Call a poison control center for treatment advice.
IF INHALED	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Move person to fresh air.If person is not breathing or an ambulance, then provide artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.Call a poison control center for further treatment advice.
IF IN EYES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Hold eye open and rinse gently with water for 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing.Call poison control center for treatment advice.
IF SWALLOWED	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Call a poison control center immediately for treatment advice.Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
