Be Prepared

- Only applicants with a bachelor's degree will be admitted into the certificate program. (No bachelor's degree? Email lgaechte@uwyo.edu for options).
- The University of Wyoming requires a \$50 fee to process your application. Unless you have already paid a UW *graduate* application fee, please be prepared to make an online payment before you can submit your application.
- The University of Wyoming requires receipt of your official transcripts before you can be admitted. To expedite your admission, please request official transcripts from all previous institutions attended, in addition to uploading your unofficial transcripts here.

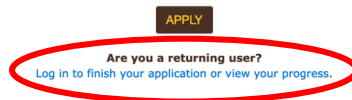
Beginning the Application
