Environmental Health

Open to high-achieving undergraduates online, asynchronous



This course helps students identify and evaluate environmental hazards, using current case studies in environmental health to illustrate how our global ecosystems are intrinsically related to human health. It introduces students to environmental justice, toxicology, and risk assessment. To help students imagine solutions to environmental hazards, the course integrates components of risk management, (eco)systems thinking, and the practice of environmental health professionals.
