Description

Bruce Dick came to the University of Wyoming in 1967 and served on the faculty until his untimely death in December of 1975 at the age of 47. At University of Wyoming, Bruce served as the Coordinator for Men's Physical Education, and it was through his efforts that the physical education majors were allowed to have an internship in the Laramie Public Schools prior to their student teaching. Dr. Dick was intent on giving every undergraduate student the chance to participate in extra-curricular activities, and saw to it that there were plenty available. Dr. Dick was especially fond of soccer, forming the University Soccer Club, which he also coached for many years. A placard hung on his door by his students best exemplifies his priorities at University of Wyoming; "Dr. Dick's Den, Where All Are Welcome."

The Bruce Dick Scholarship is awarded annually to one or two Physical and/or Health Education Teaching majors who will be completing the student teaching experience in the coming academic year, has a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, and shows professional promise specific to teaching.
