The goal of the legal resume is to **get an interview**. It is your one chance to make a great first impression.

Here are some helpful tips to help ensure it is a positive first impression:

- ⇒ Resume should be one page with one-inch margins. Fonts should be conservative business fonts and 10 to 12 point font size.
- ⇒ Different fonts can be used for emphasis or formatting, use two fonts maximum.
- ⇒ There is no absolute right or wrong format, ensure resume looks professional and understated. We suggest you review the templates in the POKES Resource Library under the Application Materials folder.
- ⇒ Proofread your resume several times before submitting, have colleagues proofread as well.
- ⇒ Write things out, only use abbreviations if they are universally understood.
- ⇒ Keep your resume updated! Save a new resume for each job you apply to and tailor each one.
- ⇒ Emphasize how your qualifications meet those of the position by describing parts of your education, work and life experiences that are most pertinent to the job. Be sure your resume is practice focused!
- ⇒ Include appropriate personal interests, community involvement or other relevant experience that will convey a sense of who you are as an individual and a potential employee.
