COMPETITION CREDIT AGREEMENT

Law school policy on legal competition credits is that the student is to register for that credit in the semester <u>after</u> he/she participates in a regional or national competition. However, since third year students who are participating in a spring regional competition will no longer be in law school the semester after completion, we will allow third year students participating in a spring competition to register for the credit.

There is one proviso, however. You must actually participate in the regional/national competition to get the credit for LAW 6970-01. If you are not able to participate due to illness, family emergency, etc., you would have to withdraw from the course. Thus, if you are counting on this credit for your graduation requirements, you would have to take the risk that you might lose that credit in the event you were unable to participate in the regional/national competition. Upon completion, return this form to the College of Law Registrar.
