Free Slot exams must be taken during one of the scheduled “Free Slots” on the schedule. You need not give advance notice of when you are going to take the exam. You have the flexibility to take it during any of the Free Slots. As a matter of process, everyone in the exam room starts work at the same time.

Simplified – the steps are:

1. Get settled 10-15 minutes before taking each exam.
2. An email will be sent with your exam passwords a few minutes before the start time.
3. Begin work when the clock shows 9:00 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. (depending on the start time). Do not start before this time.
4. Keep your own time and when your time is up submit your exam and upload it. CONT. ON NEXT PAGE

EXAM RESCHEDULES & OTHER NOTES

The College of Law Honor Code strictly applies to all exams. No student is required to take: (1) two exams on one day, or, (2) three exams in three consecutive days, or (3) four exams in five days*. ***Other exceptions to the schedule will only be granted in extreme circumstances.*** A student who wants to reschedule an exam based on the above criteria must submit an exam reschedule form to the Registrar, Dave Bluemel, **no later than 2 weeks prior to the first day of exams.** The form is on the website. Exams are **not** normally rescheduled outside of the regular exam period.

***Please note:** Students who have six final exams cannot be provided relief due to the limited number of exam days. Efforts will be made, however, to distribute the six exams so as to avoid three in a row.
