THIS MATTER comes before the Court on its own motion. The Court has now completed the adjudication of state water rights covered by this Court's 1997 *Amended Phase Big Horn Adjudication Phase III - Procedures*. Matters presented to the Court under Phase I and Phase II of the litigation were previously decided by final orders of this Court.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. All rights to the use of water in the Big Horn River System and all other sources, Water Division III, State of Wyoming, subject to adjudication in this action have been finally adjudicated by this Court.
2. The procedures for adjudication of state water rights and procedures for petitions regarding those rights contained in the 1997 *Amended Big Horn Adjudication Phase III - Procedures* are hereby terminated.
3. The Board of Control and State Engineer shall exercise their statutory authority regarding water rights adjudicated in this adjudication subject to judicial review as provided by Wyo. Stat. § 41-4-401 (LexisNexis 2013), the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. Ann. §§ 16-3-101 through 16-3-115 (LexisNexis 2013), or other applicable law.
4. If judicial review of a Board of Control or State Engineer action is sought pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 41-4-401 (LexisNexis 2013), the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. Ann. §§ 16-3-101 through 16-3-115 (LexisNexis 2013), or other applicable law, the presiding district court judge may at any time on the judge's

own motion order a change of judge when it appears that the ends of justice would be promoted thereby pursuant to Rule 40.1(b)(4) W.R.C.P.


