Book X. Title XLVII.

Concerning decrees of the decurions granting any persons immunity (from liturgies). (De decretis decurionum super immunitate quibusdam concedenda.)

10.47.1. Emperors Diocletian and Maximian to Ursinus.

Except to teachers of the liberal arts and except to physicians, no immunity (from liturgies) can be granted to any person by decree of the decurions.¹

10.47.2. The same Emperors and the Caesars to Cassius.

Unwarranted decrees of the municipal senate are annulled by the imperial constitutions.
