If a minor wants restitution against a compromise or partition.

2.31.1. Emperors Severus and Antoninus to Honoratus.

Since it has been decided that the female minor under the age of puberty is to be restored to her rights and the compromise or partition is to be rescinded, you also may employ the same rights of action which you formerly had.

2.31.2. Emperors Diocletian and Maximian and the Caesars to Hymnoda.

If restitution of rights against a compromise is asked on the part of minors, on account of the aid to be extended to their age, your interests, too, must be consulted, either if you sue anew, or by a replication to the defense that a pact was entered into, or if it is clear that the former obligation is extinguished, by giving you an action on a reinstated suit.
