If in a cause which is in common with others, restitution of rights is demanded.

2.25.1. Emperors Diocletian and Maximian and the Caesars to Domitius and Aphobius.

Your sister, even if over twenty-five years of age, could not in any way diminish your rights if you did not give her a mandate (authority) or ratify a compromise made by her. But if you, knowing what she did, gave your consent (ratification) after you became twenty-five years of age, then, although she, as a minor, is able to ask for restitution of her rights as to her own portion, her age is not able to help you in participating in the benefit of the perpetual edict.
