Title by prescription to movable things given as a dowry may be acquired by one who receives them in good faith, although they belong to some one else, provided that there is no defect (otherwise).¹

¹ [Blume] That is, e.g., they must not be stolen or taken from the possessor by force, or held merely at the pleasure of the owner.
