Title XXXXVII. (XXXXVI)

That the use of Arms without imperial knowledge be prohibited.
(Ut armorum usus inscio principe interdictus sit.)

11.47.1. Emperors Valentinian and Valens to Bulephorus, Consular of Campania.
No one whatever shall, without our knowledge and advice, be granted permission
to carry arms on a journey.
Given at Altinus October 5 (364).
