

Video Game Console Set-Up

1. Locate the input screen. Touch this screen once to start the system.



2. Plug in your console's power cord into the control system located inside the cabinet.



3. Place your console on the cabinet countertop, or on the adjacent chair's table as pictured below.

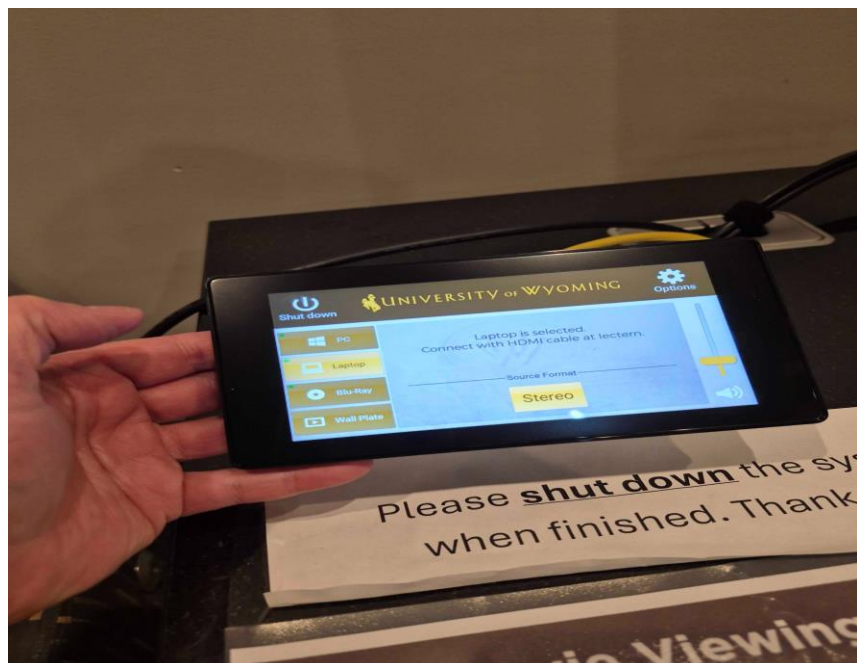


4. Use the provided HDMI cable to connect your console to the system.





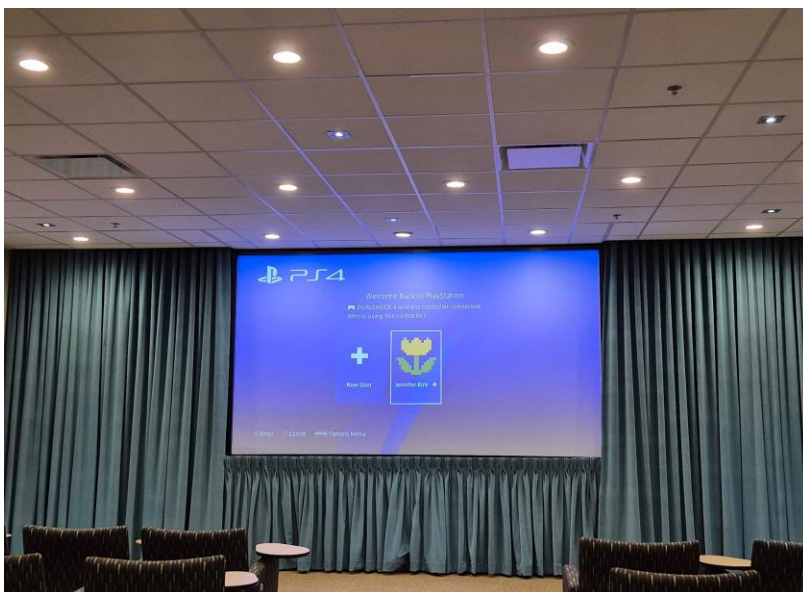
5. Select “Laptop” on the left column of the Input Control Screen. The audio will connect to the speakers automatically, and the volume of your media can be adjusted with the slider located on the right side of the Input Control Screen.



6. Turn on the console and connect your controllers if needed.



7. Connect to the internet and log into your account as needed.
 - ★ Please note: Only consoles that have an established connection to the internet prior to entering the library will be able to connect. All downloaded or physical disk games can be accessed without a connection to the internet.



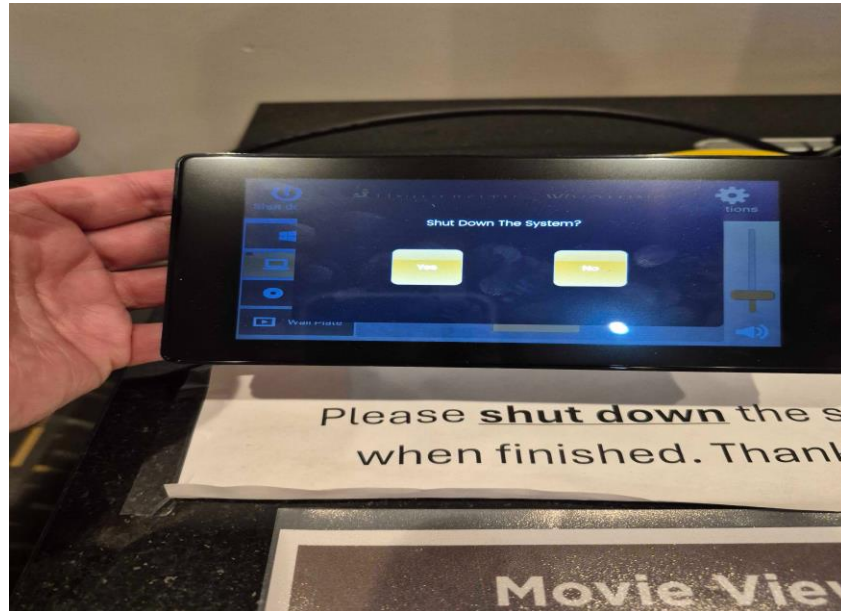
8. Launch your game and have fun!



9. Once finished, close your game and complete the proper shut down process for your specific console. Then, disconnect the HDMI cable from your device and unplug your device's power cord from the control system cart.



10. Lastly, press the “shut down” button on the top left of the input control screen. Select “yes” once prompted to finish powering down the software.



Before leaving the space, please ensure the doors of the cart are closed, the chairs are returned to their original orientation (see separate chair layout guide), and all of the lights are off in the space. Thank you!
