PREPARING FOR ARRIVAL!

The clock is ticking, and you will soon move to your home-away-from-home at UW! We are so excited to welcome you next month!

In this final edition of Contracts Chronicles, we will highlight a few dates and things you should do prior to your move.

- **TODAY:** If you have not already submitted your photo to the WyoOne ID Office, do so today! Complete this step of your [WyoChecklist](#) to ensure your WyoOne ID is printed and available for you on arrival. Your WyoOne ID is your access key to your building, room, dining center, and dining dollars. You will also need it to access the gym at Half Acre. ***This is SUPER IMPORTANT!!!*** If you have not completed this step, your move-in process will be more complicated.
- **July 24 (end of day):** Check your UW Email for Room Placement Information!
 - Residence hall, room number, mailing address, roommate name & contact information, move-in timeslot, and more will be included!
 - *Need to Make Alternate Move-In Plans?*
 - If you need to arrive any time prior to your scheduled move-in date, use the link included in the Room Placement Email to make your request.
- *Want to Update your Meal Plan Selection?*
 - Also included in the Room Placement Email will be a link to update your meal plan.
- **August 14 (end of day):** Move-In Reminder Email, including driving directions and move-in day-of instructions.
- **August 21-22:** Saddle Up Move-In!
 - It's finally here! Arrive during your scheduled move-in timeslot and follow the directions based on your hall assignment. Once moved in, check in with Saddle Up outside of North Hall or McIntyre Hall!
- **August 29:** Move-In Day for Returning Students & Housing Contract Start Date
- **August 31:** First Day of Fall Semester Classes
- **September 7:** Labor Day; No Classes
- **September 11:** Last Day to Decrease your Fall Semester Meal Plan

MOVE-IN GUIDE

- **Explore the online Move-In Guide!** Check it out for information about recommended travel routes to your hall, check-in, and parking when you arrive at campus.
- With ongoing construction, it will be especially important to review the suggested routes for travel based on your assigned residence hall. Traffic can be challenging on move-in day. Please follow the designated route on our website to your hall for best results. Entering your hall location into a navigation system will NOT provide good direction and will add significant time to your arrival. PLEASE follow the instructions provided on the Move-In page!

POLICY UPDATES FOR NORTH & SOUTH HALLS

- Every room in North and South Halls will now include a microfridge! These microwave/refrigerator combination units have been selected to work safely and reliably with the buildings' arc-fault breaker systems. As a result, residents may not bring personal microwaves or refrigerators into these buildings. Check out these tips to avoid tripping room breakers!
- Command Strips are no longer allowed in the new residence halls as they damage the walls on removal. Push pins and painter's tape are permitted as you decorate your space in these two halls.
 - *Pro-Tip!* To avoid damage charges at move-out, be mindful of how you fasten decorations to the walls. Painter's tape can be placed on the wall and command strips attached to the painter's tape for clean removal.



NEED EXTRA STORAGE SPACE?

Consider renting a storage locker or ski locker for the year!

Storage lockers are located outside McIntyre Hall, White Hall, and Tobin House. These lockers are perfect for bike storage or extra space to keep bulky items. Storage lockers are not 100% waterproof. We recommend storing items other than bikes in plastic totes to prevent water damage. More information, including dimensions and cost, can be found on our [website](#).

Ski lockers will be available in North Hall this fall. These will provide an easily accessible indoor space perfect for skis or other recreational gear. Compartment size is 12" wide x 20" deep x 80" tall. Rental rates are available at the above link.

You can reserve either locker type by completing this [Locker Reservation](#) in the Housing Portal. Your student account will be billed in the fall semester for the rental.
