## DINING CENTER AT NORTH HALL

A brand-new Dining Center, located in North Hall, opened Fall 2025! This two-story facility serves as the central dining location for all students. It has been designed to feature 8 serving platforms offering a variety of entrées. Unique to this dining hall is a station we call “The Extra Mile.” This station accommodates dietary needs, with consistent availability of meals tailored for diners with food allergies and restrictions.

In addition to the new Dining Center, High-Altitude Performance Center, also known as the HAPC Training Table, is available for our student athletes. Qualifying student athletes have access to both the Training Table (during the week) and our new Dining Center (weekends).

## RESIDENTIAL MEAL PLANS

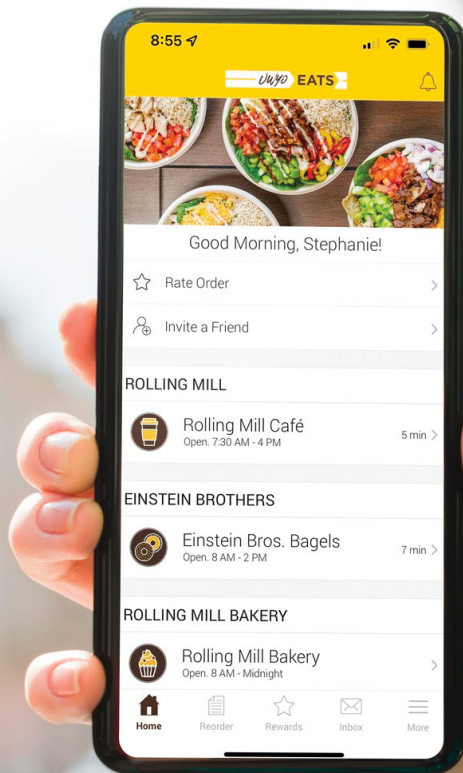
Two meal plan options will be available for residential students during the academic year: 7-Day Unlimited and 5-Day Unlimited. The 7-Day plan provides unlimited access to the Dining Center every day of the week and comes with \$150 in Dining Dollars per semester. The 5-Day plan allows unlimited access Monday through Friday and includes \$300 in Dining Dollars per semester. These Dining Dollars can be used at any on-campus dining location, including all on campus restaurants, cafés, and vending machines. Just swipe your WyoOne ID card for access to the Dining Center or to use your Dining Dollars!

As an added bonus, residential meal plan holders also receive five guest meal swipes per semester. These can be used to treat visiting friends or family at the Dining Center and allow you to enjoy a meal together.

In a hurry? Each residential plan includes up to 60 To-Go Meals from the dining facility each semester! Simply inform the cashier that you'd like your meal 'To-Go' and you will receive a disposable container to take out your meal.

In addition to the two plans above, residents of our Upperclassman Hall at Orr will have a flexible Block 225 meal plan option. It will include \$500 Dining Dollars.

If you need to adjust your meal plan, the final day to decrease your plan from the 7-Day to the 5-Day is September 11th. After that date, decreases in meal plans are no longer permitted until the spring semester; but don't worry, you can always increase your meal plan, if needed!



## THERE'S AN APP FOR THAT!

To manage your meal swipes and Dining Dollars, you'll want to download the **Transact eAccounts App** for your WyoOne Card. The app allows you to check your current Dining Dollar or Campus Dollar balance, view your transaction history, and purchase additional Dining Dollars if needed.

1. Go to your App Store or Google Play
2. Search "Transact eAccounts" and download
3. Once the app has been downloaded, select "University of Wyoming"
4. Sign in with your WyoWeb username and password

It's easy with the **UWyo Eats App!** Browse our locations and menus, place an order, and pay by credit, debit, or Dining Dollars. You'll be notified every step of the way and messaged when your order is ready. No more wasted time waiting in line! We'll even remember your favorites so you can reorder superfast!

1. Download the Transact Mobile Ordering app to your mobile device from the App Store or Google Play
2. Select "UWYO Eats"
3. Place your first order



## ON CAMPUS RESTAURANTS

In addition to the Dining Center, the University of Wyoming offers a variety of on-campus dining options that accept Dining Dollars, cash, or card.

For coffee, the Book & Bean, located in Coe Library, is a cozy shop that offers a variety of hot and cold beverages, along with pastries and snacks. For bagels and breakfast on the go, Einstein Bros Bagels in the Enzi STEM Building is a favorite. It serves fresh bagels, breakfast sandwiches, coffee, and lunch options. Another good place for a morning stop is Elements, located in the Classroom Building, where you can pick up coffee and a breakfast sandwich before class.

Bucking Horse Bakery, a new retail coffee and bakery outlet, is located within the dining hall, offering a convenient stop for a quick coffee or snack between classes or after dining. If you're near the Buchanan Center, Encore Café provides soups, paninis, and a selection of hot and cold beverages.

In the Wyoming Union, you'll find several popular spots. Chick-fil-A serves its well-known quick service menu, while Cowboy Joe's (CJ'S) Convenience Store provides a selection of personal items, cold drinks, snacks, and grab-and-go meals. Panda Express, also located in the Union, is a fan favorite that offers fast Chinese food. Rolling Mill Café is another convenient place to grab a fresh pastry or panini on your way to or from class.

And finally, the ever-popular Pokes Pub! Located in the lower level of the Union, Pokes Pub offers a variety of locally brewed beers and seltzers on tap, as well as non-alcoholic beverages and mocktails for our students who are under 21. There is something for everyone!
