The Purpose of the Friends:

...is to facilitate the attainment of the mission of the Fay W. Whitney School of Nursing (FWWSON)

Mission:

Through research of healthcare issues and education of nurse leaders, we aim to improve, promote, and protect health for Wyoming and beyond.

To that end:

The Friends commitment will be resource creation to support and advocate for the FWWSON

- Resource creation will be fluid, flexible, and timely to meet current needs.
- Current needs will be identified in collaboration with the dean, faculty, students, the FWWSON Alumni Association, Community Partners, UW Foundation, and others as applicable.
- Annual process of resource creation goal(s) for the next year will be set by the Friends at the annual meeting.

Structure:

- 1. Two Co-Chairs will be appointed by the Friends Board to work with the Dean.
- 2. <u>Size</u>: The board can grow/shrink depending on priorities and member expertise.
- 3. <u>Term</u>:
 - a. *Friends'* members are not held to a strict term but will be given the opportunity to review their commitment on an annual basis. A letter will be sent annually in January giving the opportunity to continue on the board or step off the board.
 - b. *Friends'* officers (Co-Chairs) should serve a two-year term, may serve two consecutive terms, and then will step down. They may come back on as an officer at a later time, and again serve up to two consecutive terms.
