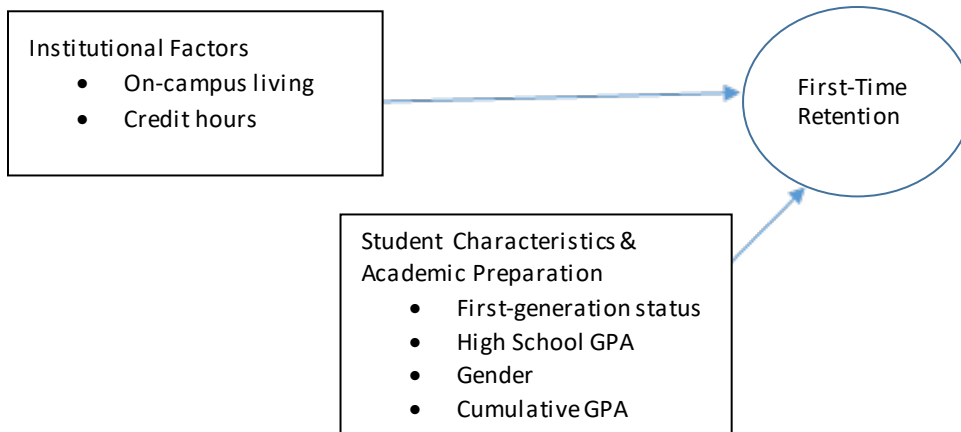




Dear Colleagues – The purpose of this Info Blast is to inform you about the types of information our office puts together and to provide a brief summary of different projects we work on along with the findings. This time we want to highlight a predictive analysis regarding first-time students and point you to the latest census counts for fall.

Predictors of First-Time Student Retention at UW

A predictive analytics research study conducted at OIA found that student's a first-generation status, on-campus living, gender, credit hours, cumulative UW GPA, and high school GPA are significant predictors of the first-time student's fall-to-fall retention at the UW. Retention rate is the percent of first-time freshmen enrolled in a fall semester who return to the same institution in the following fall semester.
