Established in 2011 by Randy and Shelly Eresman, the Eresman Family Engineering Endowment is a competitive scholarship available to undergraduate and graduate students from the Northern Alberta Institute of Technology (NAIT) and the Southern Alberta Institute of Technology (SAIT) interested in transferring to the University of Wyoming in pursuit of an energy and petroleum degree.



CRITERIA

Applicants must be admitted to the University of Wyoming College of Engineering and Physical Sciences with a declared major in Energy and Petroleum Engineering by March 15, 2024, in order to be considered.

AWARD

Up to four \$7,500 scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis.

APPLICATION PROCESS

A letter including:

- Your major, your present G.P.A. and your class (senior or junior) for the year you are seeking the scholarship.
- A paragraph (less than 200 words) describing your career plans and aspirations.

A resume including:

- Student engineering societies in which you are a member and a description of your involvement in each.
- Extra-curricular activities (campus, community, church, etc.).
- A summary of your work history including part-time and full-time employment during the academic years and summers.

One letter of reference from an individual having knowledge of your participation in extracurricular activities and/or work history.
