The University of Wyoming's offers three specialized graduate programs designed to equip students with the technical expertise and practical experience needed for success as drilling engineers:

- **Master of Engineering with Specialization in Advanced Drilling**

Complete 30 credits of coursework in as little as one year (3 semesters) with this flexible degree designed for industry professionals. **This option is available on campus, online, and in hybrid mode.**

- **Research-Based Master of Science with Drilling Focus (MS Plan A)**

Complete 26 credits of coursework and 4 credits of thesis research related to drilling engineering applications. **This option is available on campus only.**

- **Course-Based Master of Science with Drilling Focus (MS Plan B)**

Complete 28 credits of coursework and 2 credits of research credits related to drilling engineering applications. **This option is available on campus only.**

ADMISSION PROCESS ●



Eligibility: Admission to the program is open to individuals who possess a bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better, on a 4.0 scale. Applicants with 2+ years of post-graduate experience in a relevant field are eligible for *Professional Track Admission* with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better.

Required Application Materials: Prospective students may apply using the link below. The online application requires payment of a \$50 U.S. application fee. This fee will not be waived by UW Admissions or the Department.

- Unofficial College Transcripts
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae
- Three Academic or Professional References
- Statement of Purpose describing your professional and educational background, how the program will help you meet your career or academic goals, and why you chose to apply to the University of Wyoming for graduate study.

Scholarship Eligibility: Recipients must be a U.S. Citizen or Green Card Holder who meets the minimum criteria for regular admission.
