## Admissions and P2 & P4 Rotation Requirements Checklist

**VERY IMPORTANT!!!!** If requirements are not met, it will delay or possibly cancel your rotations!

Use this checklist to track your rotation requirements.

Actual copies of all documents **MUST** be completed and uploaded into **CORE** no later than end of April. For P3s **ALL** 6 Co-Curricular activities and 5 CE Impact CE's must be completed, recorded in **CORE** and successfully passed.

### NO EXECPTIONS!

<b>COVID-19 Vaccination</b>	Not required by UWSOP. Many rotations sites may require proof of vaccination <b>AND</b> an annual update, or a declination form to be completed.
<b>*Hepatitis B 1-3 or Hepatitis B Titer</b>	<b>Admission requirement:</b> 3 shot series or positive titer. This is a rotation requirement for all sites. Many rotation sites are now requiring a positive Hepatitis B Titer and a Hepatitis booster dose.
<b>Influenza (Required for rotations)</b>	Annually by October 15th or earlier if needed by rotation site.
<b>MMR 1-2 or MMR Titer</b>	<b>Admission requirement:</b> 2 shot series or positive titer. This is a rotation requirement for all sites.
<b>Tdap</b>	<b>Admission requirement:</b> This is a rotation requirement for all sites. Renewal every 10 years.
<b>**2 Step TB Test, Annual PPD, OR T spot OR QuantiFERON- TB Gold Blood Test, CXR</b>	<b>Admission requirement:</b> 2 step PPD to be followed up annually with a 1 step PPD prior to expiration of 2 step read date. This is a rotation requirement for all sites.
<b>Varicella 1-2 or Varicella Titer</b>	<b>Admission requirement:</b> 2 shot series or positive titer. This is a rotation requirement for all sites.

\*We are seeing a lot of Hospitals *requiring* a Hepatitis B booster AND Hepatitis Titer.

\*\* 2 step PPD involves administering 2 PPD tests. The 1st test is placed on one forearm then read 1-3 days after placement.

The 2nd test is placed on the other forearm 1-3 weeks after the 1st test. Then 1-3 days after placement the 2nd test is read.

For those of you who are from Wyoming or Colorado, you can request your immunization records from the State of Wyoming or State of Colorado. They will all be on 1 document. Here are the links.
