To access these two CEImpact CE courses, follow the steps below:


1. Sign into your eValue account
2. Click on the "Learning Modules" tab
3. Click on the "CEImpact" link in the blue ribbon right below the program tabs
4. Click on the "Connect to CEImpact Account"
5. Use the Preceptor Access Code: UWY23
6. Click on the "Preceptor" link under the "Course Catalog" heading
7. Look for the titles, "Number Needed to Tweet: Incorporating Technology into Experiential Learning" and "Precept2Practice: Using Social Media to Engage Experiential Learners"

The "Number Needed to Tweet: Incorporating Technology into Experiential Learning" CE course provides 0.2 CEUs, and the Precept2Practice podcast, "Using Social Media to Engage Experiential Learners" provides 0.05 CEUs.
