The two preceptors selected for this prestigious honor for the last academic year were Jade Enevoldsen and Kylee Willoughby.

Jade Enevoldsen:

Jade graduated from the University of Wyoming School of Pharmacy in 2007 and has since spent 16 years working for Walmart Health and Wellness in a retail setting. Growing up in a small town in western Nebraska, he learned the importance of community and helping others.
