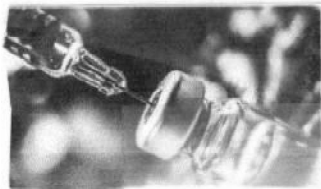
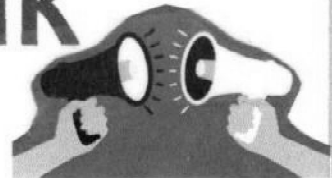

Modus Tollens

Modus tollens is the name of any argument in the following form:

If A then B.

B is not the case.

Therefore, A is not the case either.

FOR EXAMPLE:

If you get the bon bons, you won't need popcorn.

Charlie needed popcorn.

So he did not get the bon bons.

Modus Ponens

Modus ponens is the name of any argument in the following form:

If A then B.

A is true.

Thus, B is also true.

FOR EXAMPLE:

If you buy the jumbo popcorn, then you will need a large drink.

You bought the jumbo popcorn.

So you will need a large drink.
