

Bucket Golf Rules

(Updated 6/19/2024)

All players must present a valid photo ID prior to each game. No exceptions!


Campus Recreation Staff will have the final say on all rules and their application. Spectators must remain in the designated areas. Misconduct of spectators, players, or coaches can result in an ejection or forfeiture of the game.

RULES

- 1. Each player may only use one club per game, no switching allowed.
- 2. Safety is the highest priority.
- Treat the equipment with respect...there are limited clubs, so help us keep as many as we can!
- 4. Depending on the number of players, players may be asked to wait until others are finished on a hole to begin their attempt.
- 5. Two hands must be on the club through the entire swing, no "scooping" to get a chip-in

Course setup:

- Supervisors will set up the course.
- The distance for each hole should be between 10-30 yards.
- Things like rocks and trees are a part of the course and are considered obstacles.
- The course will be played on the southern part of Prexy's Pasture, circled in red:

Scoring

- For simplicity, scoring is treated like putt-putt
 - No pars, only running tally of total strokes
- Score is kept the same as regular golf, the player with the lowest score wins.
- Hitting any part of the bucket completes the hole; chipping your ball inside the bucket deducts one stroke from your score on that hole. Only hitting the flagpole does not count.
- If a player hits their ball into an obstacle (like a bush), they must take a drop no closer to the hole from where the ball went out, and a 1 stroke penalty.
- Each player is responsible for keeping track of their own score and reporting it.
