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**Meetings:** The UCRC Committee met monthly, generally on the third Thursday, from September 2025 through April 2026. Based on the number of CAPs reviewed during the fall months, the committee also met on the fourth Thursday of the month. All meetings were conducted over Zoom, which allowed for screen sharing when reviewing course action proposals (CAPs). Meetings are scheduled for 3 hours.

**Course Action Proposal (CAP) Review:** The UCRC reviewed a total of 444 proposals in 2025-26, the majority of which were new or modified courses. While course discontinuations represented 25% of the total CAPs reviewed, the majority (73%) of those discontinuations were removing an old course prefix (THEA) after all Theatre and Dance courses were changed to a new prefix (THDN). See the table below for additional details and a comparison to academic year 2024-25 and 2023-24. The specific courses reviewed and approved by the committee can be found in the appendix.

**Other Committee Action:**

- Improvements to the CAP process and Modern Campus Curriculum workflow:
  - The University of Wyoming began using the Modern Campus Curriculum (formerly Curriculog) system in academic year 2022-23. The UCRC and the Office of the Registrar work together to identify adjustments that can be made within the system to improve

the course review process for departments, the UCRC committee, and the Office of the Registrar.

- When Modern Campus Curriculum was implemented, the workflow required users to include a syllabus for every new or modified CAP. Starting in academic year 2025-26, syllabi only had to accompany CAPS for certain course modifications (i.e. changes in credit hours, dual-listed courses, or those with USP changes) and for all new courses.
- For academic year 2026-27, two additional enhancements will be made:
  - For course modifications, if the originator is making a simple or singular change (e.g. change in course name), they will no longer be asked to complete other fields (course description, pre-reqs, grading system, etc) or have those fields be visible. This should streamline data entry, minimize confusion, and the potential for unintended changes.
  - For new courses, the originator will specify if the proposed new course is part of an already established program or a program under consideration (i.e. undergoing the Notice of Intent or Request for Authorization process). The UCRC recognizes the timing challenges for program/certificate approval and the timeline for course approvals.
- The UCRC distributed a CAP guidance document in December 2025. This document was distributed to each college through committee members and highlighted tips to avoid common pitfalls seen by the committee during Fall 2025.
- Recommendations for Faculty Senate Standing Committee bylaws:
  - The committee appreciated the opportunity to meet with Faculty Senate Chair, Rob Godby, on two occasions during the academic year to discuss committee functions and provide recommendations for updating the Faculty Senate standing committee bylaws.
