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## Major in English Program Notes:

- A minimum of 120 hours is required.
- $\bullet\,$  A minimum of 42 hours must be upper division (3000 & 4000 level).

A minimum of 21 hours of ENGL coursework must be at the upper division (3000 & 4000 level).

- · Degree Candidates must meet the academic requirements of the university, and must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses required for the major.
- Grades of C or better are rquired for all prerequisite courses.
- Students may not take a couse for S/U credit to satisfy any requirement, unless the course is offered for S/U credit only.

## College of Arts and Sciences Requirements

- Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG). These
  courses may be embedded in the English major.
- No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation.
- All courses in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better.

## University of Wyoming Requirements

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
- Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming.
- Courses must be taken for a single letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
- University Studies Program (USP), Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be crosslisted with the major.
