Students should review the course descriptions in the University Catalog and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly.

## University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. - Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. - Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U. - University Studies Program (USP) Human Culture (H) and Physical \& Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

## College of Arts and Sciences requirements:

Students must take two "core" courses in addition to the USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG). - No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation (128 for professional programs). - At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (the major may require more).
