MINIMUM TOTAL CREDIT HOURS: 127

This is a guide for course work in the major; actual course sequence may vary by student. Please refer to the online student degree evaluation, and consult with an academic advisor. • Not all courses are offered every semester and some electives may have prerequisites. Students should review the course descriptions in the *University Catalog* and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly.

University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U. • University Studies Program (USP) Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

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College of Arts and Sciences requirements:

Students must take two "core" courses in addition to the USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG). • No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation. • At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (the major may require more).

Music Education Program Notes:

A grade of C must be earned in all MUSC courses. • As a professional degree, the Bachelor of Music Education requires students to take more than 60 hours in their major subject. • Students must apply for admission to Phase III in the College of Education in the fall semester of the junior year. • Throughout the four-year Music Education program, there are critical decision points to help the student and music faculty assess if Music Education is an appropriate career path. These decision points assess proficiency and satisfactory academic performance as required by the Music Department and the Music Education Committee. • Music Education students must apply for Phase IIIa (Elementary and Secondary Music Methods) and IIIb (Student Teaching) in December of the year before the fall in which they intend to enroll in phase courses. The Music Education Coordinator will screen applicants to ensure they have met the criteria for enrolling in Phase IIIa and IIIb, including minimum GPA of 2.75 and planned completion of all music education coursework.

- * All music majors must successfully complete MUSC 0200 (Music Convocation) each semester and must enroll in lessons and one ensemble per semester. All music majors begin applied lessons at the 2000-level. Previous training must be proven with an audition. Music majors must play in one ensemble each semester; scholarship recipients must play in two ensembles each semester.
- ** Elementary Class Piano I-IV is highly recommended for students with little or no piano experience. All music majors must pass a piano proficiency test during their sophomore year (MUSC 2395). If a student opts not to take Elementary Class Piano I-IV, then four (4) hours of elective credit must be taken to ensure 127 hours for graduation.
- *** Required for Vocal Emphasis majors.
- **** Music majors may not continue to 4000-level lessons without successful completion of the sophomore jury.
