# **Secondary German Education, BA** with Concurrent<sup>†</sup> Major in German



### University of Wyoming, 2016-17

The Secondary German Education BA Program is currently under review for potential elimination. No students will be admitted to this program after August 1, 2017. Students admitted prior to August 1, 2017 will have the opportunity to complete the program as outlined below.

The College of Education maintains rigorous admission standards to ensure the quality of preparation for future educators. **New, first time students** who meet the University of Wyoming's standards for admission may declare a major in elementary education, secondary or K-12 education in a specific content area, or education undecided provided they have a minimum ACT composite score of 21 and ACT math score of 21; a lower ACT math score can be replaced by a UW Math Placement Exam (MPE) score of 2 or higher. If electing to pursue education undecided, it is recommended that students decide on their teaching content area no later than the first semester of their sophomore year.

Current UW students wishing to change their major, students seeking re-admission to UW, or those transferring to UW from another institution can learn more about the specific admission requirements for these groups at www.uwyo.edu/ted/admission requirements.html.

All students must undergo and pass an initial criminal background check prior to full admission to the College of Education. Any costs associated with the background check are the responsibility of the student. A second background check is included as part of the state application process for the Wyoming Substitute Teaching Permit, which is required for admission to Phase II of UW's teacher education program and is pursued after students have completed 65 credit hours toward their degree. Criminal background checks are a standard for the profession.

This is a guide for course work in the major; actual course sequence may vary by student. Please refer to the online student degree evaluation, and consult with an academic advisor. • Not all courses are offered every semester and some electives may have prerequisites. Students should review the course descriptions in the *University Catalog* and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly.

#### **University of Wyoming requirements:**

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U. • University Studies Program (USP) Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

#### **College of Education requirements:**

This plan assumes student college readiness. Students should be able to start taking 1000-level courses the first semester of college. • All professional education courses must be completed with a grade of C or higher. Grades of C- or lower will not satisfy this requirement.

† Concurrent Majors. Students may pursue a concurrent major in one or more colleges. Only one degree (BA, BS, etc.) will be awarded from the college of the primary major. All university curricular requirements, including the University Studies Program requirements, must be met only once. Requirements for secondary major/s will be established by the academic departments and may include college requirements, in addition to all major requirements. An academic advisor in each major is required and each adviser must review requirements. The degree will be granted on one date only and only one diploma will be awarded. Both majors will be indicated on the academic transcript and diploma.

# The Wyoming Teacher Education Program operates in a series of phases: Phase II, Phase III, Phase IIIa, and Phase IIIb. Continuation in the program in any content area is dependent upon the successful completion of prerequisites for each phase. #### **Secondary German Education Program Notes:**

- A minimum 2.5 gpa is required in major content. All major content courses must be completed with a grade of C or higher. Grades of C- or lower will not satisfy this requirement.
- Studying abroad in a target language speaking country is strongly recommended. The minimum length of this experience should be one semester or two summers, both in a structured language program, preferably in a home stay situation.
  A summer session must be no shorter than a four-week intensive program in order to be counted as a study abroad opportunity.
- \* The prerequisite of a 2.50 cumulative UW gpa is waived for new, incoming freshman who have declared education as their major.
- \*\* This plan assumes the successful completion of at least three (3) years of high school-level German or successful completion of GERM 1010, 1020 and 2030 or equivalents at the post-high school level. Not being able to begin at the second year, second semester course may result in additional semesters to completion.
