Subject: Bicycle Pedestrian Safety Committee

Number: UW SAP 6-11.2

I. RATIONALE

The Bicycle Pedestrian Safety Committee addresses bicycle and pedestrian safety concerns on the University of Wyoming campus. Specific areas of concern include bicycle paths, dismount zones, sidewalks, and bicycle parking areas.

II. FUNCTIONS

The Committee functions include updating the campus bicycle map and working with UW Operations regarding the design development of new buildings or changes to campus as it relates to bicycle and pedestrian safety. The Committee also oversees the Bicycle Friendly Campus certification and may advise the University Police Department on changes to enforcement or rules related to bicycles and/or pedestrian related issues. The Committee shall meet a minimum of quarterly or more frequently as needed.

III. COMPOSITION

The Vice President for Finance and Administration shall oversee and appoint all members to serve on this Committee. The Committee shall include two members from UW Operations, one member from Campus Recreation, one member from the University Police Department, one community member, one additional member from any department, one University faculty member, and one student member with consultation from their respective Senates on selection of these members to the Committee. The Chair of the Committee will be elected by a majority vote of the existing Committee members.
