

**UW REGULATION 8-248**  
**Admission of International Students**

**1. PURPOSE**

To establish a policy for the admission of international students to the University of Wyoming and to specific programs offered by academic units. The Admission Policy for International Students shall be supplementary to existing general admission policies and procedures of the university.

**2. AUTHORITY**

The Provost & Vice President for Academic Affairs and the Vice President for Student Affairs together shall be responsible for administering this Regulation. Responsibilities, including the granting of exceptions to the policy, may be delegated to a designee.

**3. GENERAL POLICY**

The University of Wyoming seeks to admit qualified undergraduate and graduate level international students to add to the ethnic and cultural diversity of its student body and to afford opportunities for domestic students to learn from and interact with individuals from other parts of the world. Through its admission policies, the University sets standards and requirements designed to give admitted students reasonable opportunities and resources to achieve academic success.

**4. REVISION, APPROVAL, AND EFFECTIVE DATE**

The Admission Policy for International Students shall be revised as determined by the Provost & Vice President for Academic Affairs and/or the Vice President for Student Affairs. Such revisions are subject to the approval of both vice presidents and shall become effective from the date of their approval.

**5. DISTRIBUTION/NOTIFICATION**

The Admission Policy for International Students will be published and distributed by the Office of Admissions and will be available through the University's electronic information system.
