

UW REGULATION 2–32

Energy Management

I. DESIGNATION

The President, through the Directors of Physical Plant and Facilities Planning, or their designees, shall ensure that the University adheres to energy conservation and management throughout its buildings and grounds.

II. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

The Directors of Physical Plant and Facilities Planning, or their designees, shall be responsible for developing policies and procedures for the conservation of energy in all University facilities. The Directors of Physical Plant and Facilities Planning, or their designees, shall also be responsible for the implementation of such policies and procedures after they have consulted with faculty, staff and students, and been approved by the Vice President for Administration.

III. ADMINISTRATION

These duties and functions shall be performed under the general supervision of the Vice President for Administration.
