UW REGULATION 2-32 Energy Management

1. DESIGNATION.

The President shall appoint a member of the University staff or faculty to serve as Campus Energy Conservation Officer and may also appoint other persons to advise, assist or cooperate with the Conservation Officer.

2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.

The Campus Energy Conservation Officer shall be responsible for developing policies and procedures for the conservation of energy at all University facilities. This officer shall also be responsible for the implementation of such policies and procedures after they have been approved by the Vice President for Administration. Policies and procedures shall be established after consultation with faculty, staff and students. These duties and functions shall be performed under the general supervision of the Vice President for Administration.
