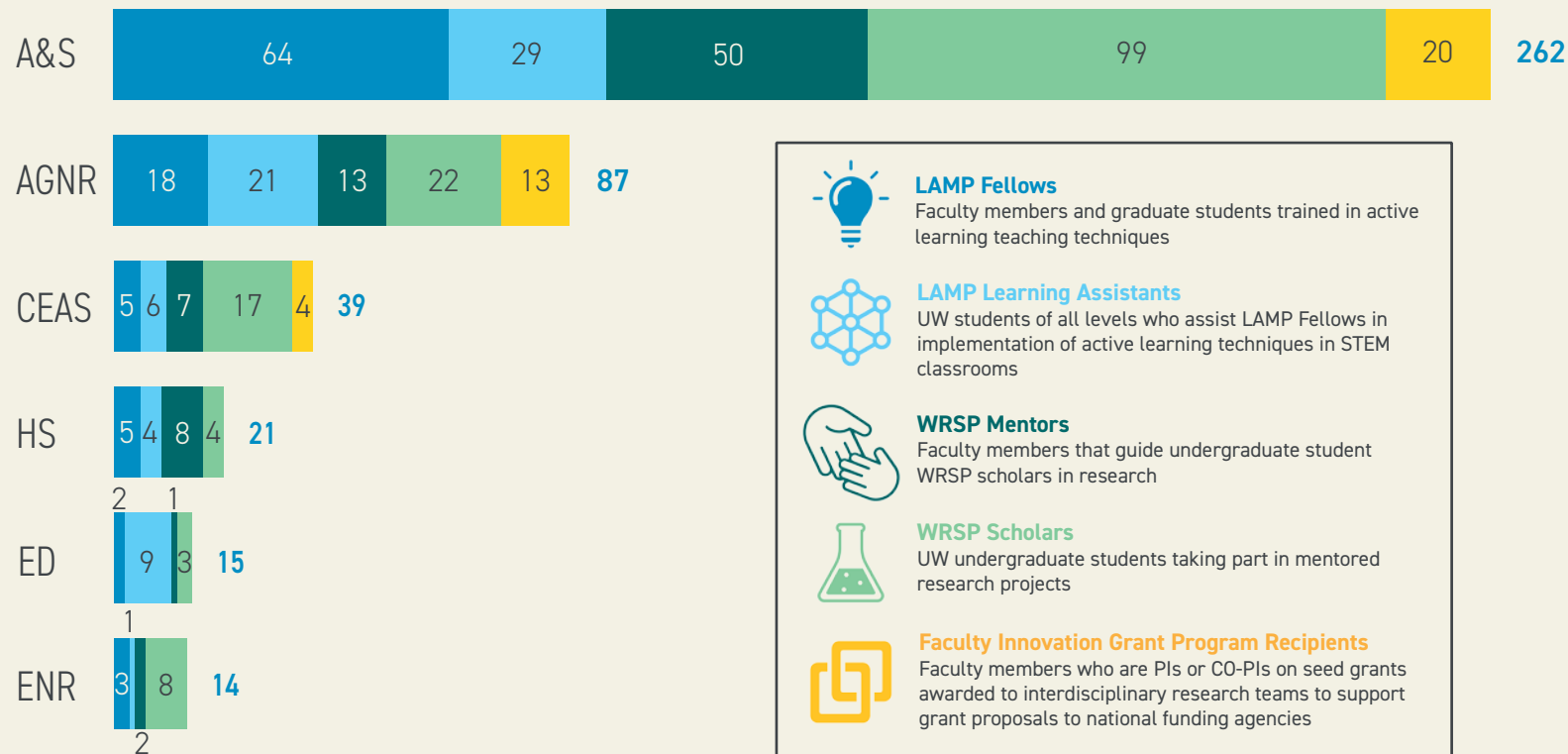


SCIENCE INITIATIVE PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS BY COLLEGE AND DEPARTMENT

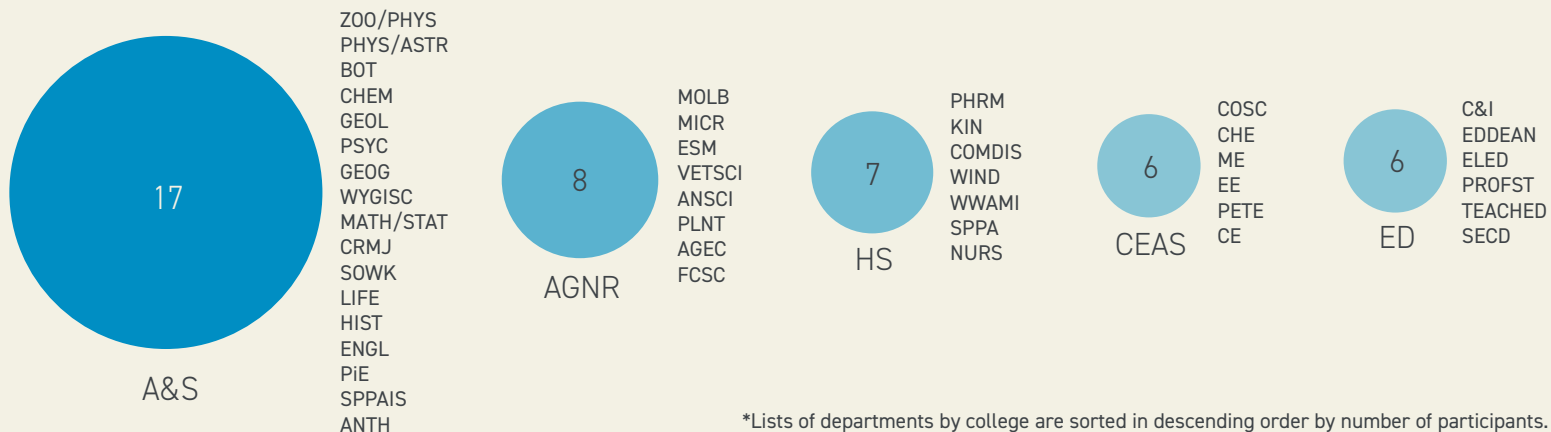

These data include both past and present participants, beginning from the inception of each program (WRSP - Fall 2015, LAMP - Fall 2016, Faculty Innovation Grant Program - Spring 2019) through Spring of 2022.

* In addition, there were 4 participants from the Honors College, 2 from the School Energy of Resources, 1 from the College of Business, and 9 from other entities.

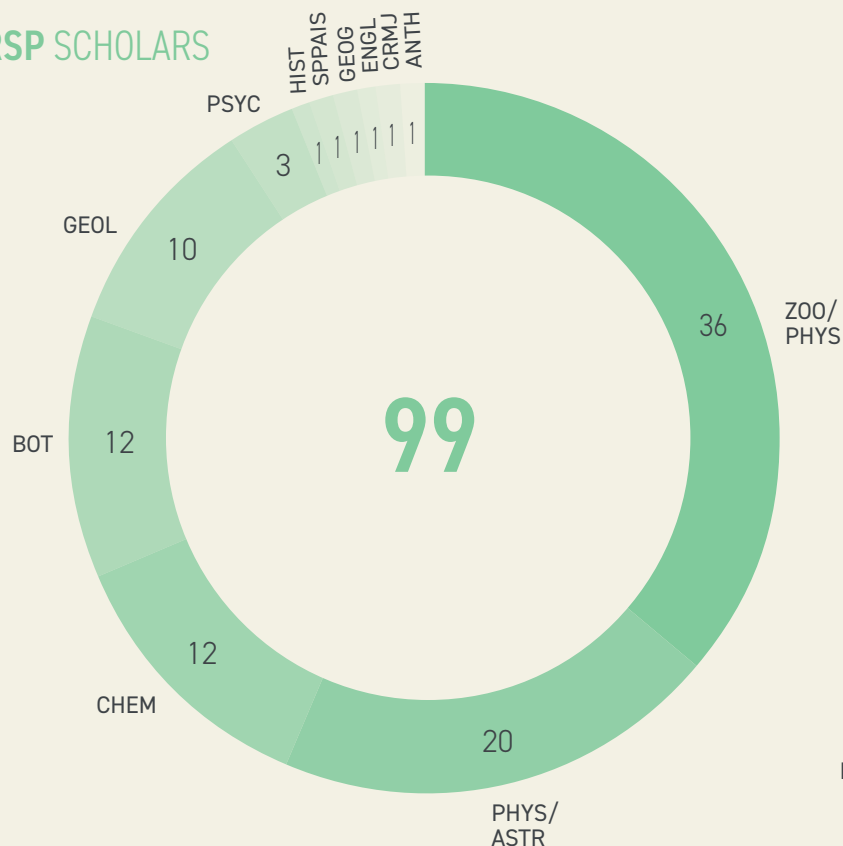
NUMBER OF DEPARTMENTS REPRESENTED BY COLLEGE



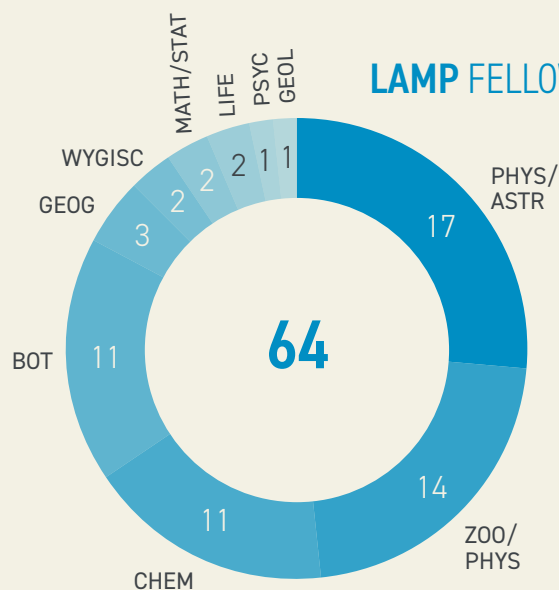

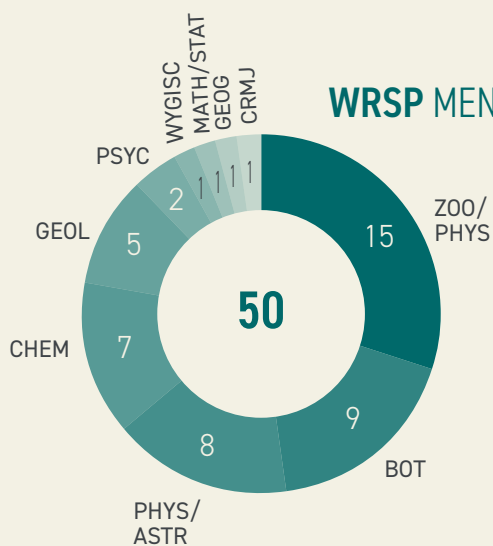

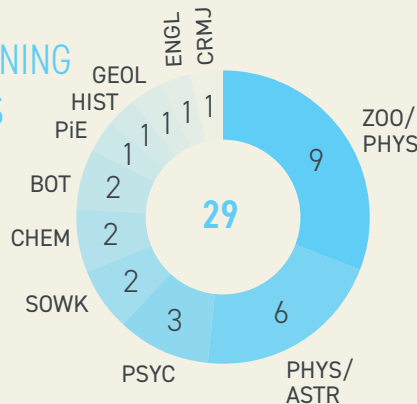
