STUDENT SUCCESS SERVICES BENEFITS INCLUDE:

ACADEMIC SUPPORT SERVICES

Advisors foster a studentcentered and welcoming environment to help program participants navigate the college process.

PRIORITY REGISTRATION

Program participants who meet with their advisor twice a semester will qualify for the opportunity to register on the first day the system is available.

ACCESS TO FREE TUTORING

In addition to University tutor offerings, program participants may receive small-group and/or private, specialized tutoring through Student Success Services.

ADDITIONAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

Program participants may receive assistance with FAFSA questions, additional financial aid opportunities, and program exclusive scholarships.

FREE CULTURAL EVENTS

Program participants are eligible to attend University sponsored arts and culture events free of charge.

Funding for the Student Success Services program is provided by the U.S. Department of Education. The D-Ed requires proof that funds are serving those for whom they are intended. For that reason, documentation of your eligibility status is required.
