2025-2026 Graduate TEACH Grant Form

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program as authorized by the U.S. Congress was implemented to encourage students interested in teaching to continue their studies and commit to serving as full-time teachers in high-need fields and underserved schools. Unlike other federal student grants, the TEACH Grant requires recipients to agree to complete at least four school years of teaching in an underserved school in a high-need field. The program also requires students to complete the required four years of teaching within eight years after they graduate from, or otherwise cease to be enrolled at, an institution of higher education.

Please carefully review the following:

- It is the responsibility of the student to confirm enrollment in a TEACH Grant eligible program
- If a student does not meet the terms and conditions of the TEACH Grant service obligation, all TEACH grants will be converted to Direct Unsubsidized Loans which must be repaid in full to the U.S. Department of Education (ED)
- Pre-majors and non-degree programs are not eligible for TEACH Grant funds
