



2025-2026 Student Application Error Resolution Form

This form is requested by the Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid when a student or parent has discrepant FAFSA information that could affect the student's financial aid award. Federal regulations require a review of any subsequent FAFSA submissions. If the applicant has made changes that impact the Student Aid Index (SAI), it is necessary to determine whether the original information submitted was accurate at the time the initial FAFSA was completed. It is possible that additional documentation may be needed to determine the appropriate FAFSA transaction for calculating the student's financial aid eligibility.
