A BILL FOR ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION COMMITTEE

1.           WHEREAS, Resolution 170 combined the Salaries & Benefits and
2.   Classification/Compensation Committees into one committee until June 30, 1997;
3.   and,
4.           WHEREAS, the efforts and results of the combined committees have been
5.   successful; and,
6.           WHEREAS, the current SBCC Committee would like to continue in this
7.   fashion;
8.           THEREFORE, be it resolved that they be permanently combined into one
9.   standing Staff Senate Committee to be called the Compensation Committee.
10.          Function   -   To advise and participate in discussions with the
11.                            University of Wyoming administration regarding salary,
12.                            benefits, and classification: to develop, process and
13.                            provide classification, salary and benefits information.
14.          Powers    -   To appoint and charge ad hoc subcommittees and to
15.                            receive proposals and gather information relative to
16.                            compensation issues.
17.          Composition - The Compensation Committee shall be comprised of at
18.                            least 11 voting members. These members are to be a mix

19. of University staff (exempt and non-exempt, Staff Senate  
20. and non-Staff Senate) with at least six of them being  
21. senators. It will have one committee chairperson who is a Staff  
22. Senator, and up to three subcommittee chairpersons to be elected by  
23. the committee The Staff Senate President and the Director of Human  
24. Resources , or their representative shall be ex-officio members of the  
25. Compensation Committee without vote.
