- III. Administration reports
 - a. Vice President of Administration Representative
 - a. VP Lowe- Update on budget request, very early in the process. In January the JAC will "Mark-up" the bill, meaning the JAC makes it recommendations etc. Support from Governor for about a 1.4% increase in salary, request for funds for tier 1 Engineering facility. Budget reduction plans, governor requested 6% for UW reduction, trying for support budgets instead of personnel, holding quarterly reviews for staff positions. (11.4 mil)

 - a. 3 years in January since there was an update to the employee handbook. HR is beginning the "Tour" to relevant groups for comments to changes in the handbook. Will introduce changes to staff senate and request feedback/suggestions early in 2013. Current handbook policy stands until final revision is disseminated. Electronic version of W-2. 925 have signed up for the electronic W-2. (as of 10 am this morning)
