


STAFF SENATE RESOLUTION #228

Title: Request for Waiver of Academic Course Program Fees for UW Employees

1 WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Mission Statement affirms that the University seeks to “promote
2 opportunities for personal growth, physical health, athletic competition, and leadership development for all
3 members of the university community,” and;
4 WHEREAS, University of Wyoming staff members currently enjoy the benefit of a tuition and mandatory fee
5 waiver for academic courses in which they are enrolled, and;
6 WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming is currently working to introduce new program fees which will
7 significantly increase the cost of taking a course for UW employees who are utilizing the tuition and fee
8 waiver program;
9 THEREFORE, be it resolved that UW Staff Senate requests that the University of Wyoming amend the
10 employee tuition and fee waiver policy to include a waiver of program fees, and;
11 THEREFORE, be it further resolved that Staff Senate requests that the University of Wyoming amend current
12 accounting policies to allow UW employees to utilize payroll deduction to pay for any fees associated with
13 courses they are enrolled in which are not included in the tuition and fee waiver policy.
