- 1 WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Staff Senate has received numerous reports of low morale and
2 low engagement at UW, and;
3 WHEREAS, research shows that workplace engagement and high morale correlate with increased
4 productivity¹, and;
5 WHEREAS, maintaining a pleasant and engaging work environment is in the interest of the students,
6 staff, faculty, and administration of UW;
7 THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Staff Senate of the University of Wyoming requests that a
8 University of Wyoming Morale Committee be formed with the goal of collaborating with
9 Administration for monitoring and improving morale on campus, and;
10 THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the University of Wyoming Morale Committee should include
11 representation from the Faculty and Staff Senates, students, and administration.
