## STAFF SENATE RESOLUTION #207

**Title:** Timely Input from Advisory Boards before Policy Implementation

1 WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming administration works closely with its advisory boards,  
2 and;

3 WHEREAS, the A.S.U.W., Faculty Senate, and Staff Senate represent the University of  
4 Wyoming, and;

5 WHEREAS, the mission of the Staff Senate is to "...fulfill its advisory capacity, while upholding  
6 the core values of unity, pride, professionalism, integrity and a dedication to honest and open  
7 communication, by providing a forum to foster and support a positive and meaningful dialogue  
8 among staff, faculty, students and administration...", and;


9 WHEREAS, University policies have an effect on the entire University community, and new  
10 policies and changes to existing policies present challenges to this community, and;

11 WHEREAS, the University President has the authority to respond to necessity with a Presidential  
12 Directive, and there are times in which these directives can, and should, be made policy;

13 THEREFORE, be it resolved that the aforementioned advisory boards shall receive notification  
14 of all proposed new policies and changes to existing policies a minimum of three months prior to  
15 implementation to allow for review, suggestions, and to provide time for campus-wide  
16 notification, and;

17 THEREFORE, be it further resolved that in matters where time is of the essence, University  
18 administration inform the executive committees of each advisory board as well in advance of  
19 policy implementation as possible.
