Title: Request to Reconvene the Employee Benefits Committee

1 WHEREAS, UW Regulation 1-2¹ establishes an Employee Benefits Committee, and;
2 WHEREAS the stated purpose of the Employee Benefits Committee is to “formulate,
3 propose and review programs of fringe benefits relating to the economic status of faculty
4 and staff, and to make recommendations to the Vice President for Administration,” and;
5 WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming is currently reviewing and readjusting employee
6 benefits in order to realize cost savings and better align UW employee benefits with
7 Wyoming state employee benefits, and;
8 WHEREAS, adjustments to employee benefits often carry unforeseen consequences and
9 implications that should be considered prior to implementation, and;
10 WHEREAS, the University does not currently have an active Employee Benefits Committee;
11 THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Staff Senate of the University of Wyoming requests that
12 the Vice President for Administration reconvene the Employee Benefits Committee.
