**Report Title:** Correction, SPRING FYS 24-25 STATS REPORT

**Introduction:** Student Legal Services (SLS) is a program through ASUW that provides free, confidential legal advice to all full-fee-paying University of Wyoming students. The FYS 2024-25-year personnel are WY licensed attorney Samantha Daniels and UW College of Law Intern Lisa "L" Hoffman. We are to report to ASUW statistics on our program quarterly.

***Further details provided below could threaten confidentiality and the attorney-client privilege.***

**DATA: Between 2/28/2025 and 5/23/25, Student Legal Services assisted 14 individuals.**

Of these individuals, 3 students were not eligible for assistance.

**Note:** Ineligibility means that either a) the student is not a full-fee paying student, which includes on-campus services like SLS, b) the student was attempting suit against another student or the University or another University entity or c) the inquiry was not one that SLS covers in its limited scope of services.

Of these 14 students, 4 did not complete the intake process.

A total of 3 referrals had to be made, which included 2 non-eligible clients and 1 eligible client.

**Note:** An incomplete intake process can mean anything from never filling out the intake form, to failing to agree to the limited scope agreement, to never providing meet times, or even missing or canceling an appointment.

The following statistics are based on the remaining 7 students we assisted. (see other attachment)

**Goals:**

1. SLS will Table during Saddle Up on Aug. 20 from 3:30-5:00 in the Union.
2. Create a FAQ page regarding visas/immigration status since SLS cannot provide full services.
3. Review eligibility rules with ASUW Student Government and Dean of Students.
