Accounting, B. S. B.

The Accounting major prepares students for a career within the profession by providing them with the skills to create, interpret and analyze economic and financial information while focusing on assurance, financial and tax services. The BSB in Accounting program is STEM designated.

Degree Requirements- Total Credits: 120

As per University Graduation Requirements, a student must complete their degree with 120 overall credits, 42 of which must be upper-division of which 30 must be taken from UW.

Completion of University Studies Program (USP).

Complete required courses.

50% of the business credit hours must be from the University of Wyoming.

Students must earn a grade of C or better in all Common Body of Knowledge, Major Specific Core, and Major courses.

Students must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA from the University of Wyoming.

Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA in all College of Business coursework.

Students must meet all graduation requirements for the College of Business.

This degree requires that The University Studies Program 2015 requirements are met before graduation. Some of the courses required for this major fulfill USP requirements, but not all. Students should check their degree evaluations and consult with their assigned academic advisor to discuss their specific course plan.

Additional Information

Students who anticipate preparing themselves for the CPA examination following completion of their degree should be aware of the Wyoming statute governing eligibility to sit for the exam. The current curricula enables students to satisfy the educational requirements to sit for the CPA exam in Wyoming and some other jurisdictions.

Notes:

University of Wyoming bachelor's degrees require students to complete 42 upper-division credit hours, including 30 upper-division credits earned in residence at UW. Students considering upper-division coursework at another institution should consult with their academic advisor to determine how those courses fit within their degree plan.
