Human Nutrition and Food (B.S.) - Dietetics Pathway

Undergraduate Program in Nutrition and Dietetics (BS-HNF)

This variation of the Bachelor's of Science in Human Nutrition and Food (BS-HNF) prepares students to enter the Graduate Program in Nutrition and Dietetics (MS-GPND) by fulfilling the core undergraduate components of the standard BS-HNF while also fulfilling the requirements needed to begin graduate coursework for their Masters in Nutrition and Dietetics.

Graduate Program in Nutrition and Dietetics (MS-GPND)

After completing the requirements for the undergraduate program on the Dietetics pathway, students may continue on to complete their 1 year Masters in preparation for the Registration Examination for Dietitians.

Notes:

Note 1: ENGL 4010 at Northwest transfers as an upper-division elective and is not equivalent to UWs ENGL 4010.

Note 2: All WYCCs offer BIOL 1010 which is equivalent to LIFE 1010.

Note 3: Casper, EWC, Sheridan and Northwest all offer FCSC 1141. CWC offers FCSC 1140. LCCC offers HOEC 1140 and Western offers HLED 1141

Note 4: Northwest offers HLED 1003. Casper, EWC, LCCC, Sheridan, Northwest and Western all offer HLED 1006. All of these courses are equivalent to UWs HLED 1006.

Note 5: KIN 2040 + 2041 is satisfied by ZOO 2015 which is offered at Casper, CWC and EWC. Students at Sheridan, Northwest and Wyoming take ZOO 2010 + 2020. Students at LCCC may choose either ZOO 2015 or ZOO 2010 + 2020 to satisfy the requirement.

Note 6: MGT 2100 is offered at Casper, EWC, LCCC, Sheridan and Western. MGT 3210 is offered at CWC, LCCC, Northwest and Western and may also satisfy the requirement.

Note 7: MOLB 2210 is equivalent to LIFE/MICR/MOLB 2021

Note 8: Northwest offers PROF 3110 which is equivalent to FCSC 3110.

Note 9: Casper FCSC 1410; CWC & LCCC FDSC 1410
