 - Secondary programs need to add courses in: ESL, practicums, working with families and an intro to education course
 - Currently secondary ed faculty are working with UW college partners regarding MOUs for concurrent majors
 - Intending to put a 51 credit hour cap on the content hour requirement

Common Course Numbering System
