EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A Request for Authorization feasibility study will be presented on the Bachelor of General Studies degree. This degree was considered for its Notice of Intent by the committee and the Board in May of 2018. The degree will replace the distributed majors in the Arts & Sciences colleges, and is targeted towards post-traditional students with some college. Tracks are offered in each college, and some will be available online. This degree will be one of the most important tools in assisting UW in it works towards meeting the ENDOW educational attainment goals.

Approval of the feasibility study will allow the cross-college team that has formulated this program to take the concept to the campus for review by Faculty Senate, Staff Senate, ASUW, Deans and Directors, and the Executive Council.
